1 ACCEPTANCE OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

Having been circulated to all members of the Council of Management, the minutes of the council meeting held on 9th February, 2026 were taken as read, confirmed, and approved.

2 MATTERS ARISING

NIL.

3 CORRESPONDENCE

HKFC requested to hold Mike Worth Memorial Cup from 18-19 October, 2026 and Hong Kong Football Club International Lawn Bowls Open 2027 from 4-7 March, 2027. There being no objection from councilors, the above competition was approved.

HKCC requested to hold the bowls tournament to celebrate 90th Anniversary of the HKCC Bowls Section on 15th August, 2026. There being no objection from councilors, the above competition was approved.

YLLBC requested to hold the Yuen Long Lawn Bowls Club Charity Invitational Tournament 2026 “元朗草地滾球會慈善邀請賽2026” from 22-26 March, 2026 at the Hong Kong Buddhist Association Chan Ma Mee York Memorial Camp. There being no objection from councilors, the above competition was approved.

4 TREASURER'S REPORT

The Honorary Treasurer expressed gratitude for the cooperation of the member clubs.

5 LEAGUE

VP (League) reported the following:

5.1 Triples League 2025

All results on website were final. Convenors could destroy the scorecards.

Panel ruling:

Deduct 2 points from ILBC-C for one player playing W4685 and W4641. Shots were adjusted.

Deduct 2 points from KCC-C for one player playing W4683 and W4651.

5.2 Last match starting at 3pm

One convenor raised a concern that many games had been rescheduled due to a shortage of greens, and asked whether the requirement of all remaining matches to start at 3:00pm should be lifted. After consideration, the League Panel recommended maintaining the status quo. All remaining matches shall continue to be scheduled for a 3:00pm start as far as practicable.

LBA would arrange the purchase of trophies through Taobao. If there was any remaining prize money after the purchase, the balance would be refunded to the players.

7 **DEVELOPMENT**

VP (Development) reported the following:

7.1 Youth Novice Lawn Bowls Competition 2026

The competition was held at ALC indoor bowls green from 08:00 to 20:00 on 8th March, 2026. Final result is as follow.

7.2 YDT coach recruitment

We started to recruit YDT coaches for the year of 2026-2027 as normal practice.

7.3 Exchange Programme and Training Camp to Australia

Two teams of YDT would travel to Australia for Exchange Programme and training camp. 12 players and 2 coaches would travel from 23-28 March, 2026 under exchange programme. 6 players and 2 officials would travel from 24-30 March, 2026 under training camp funding.

8 **TECHNICAL**

VP (Technical) reported the following:

Coaches were invited to renew the registration for 2026-28. Deadline of application was 31st March 2026.

The Umpire section of the LBA website has been updated. Coach section would be updated after coach registration renewal.

29 umpires attended the sharing session on 11th March, 2026 and had fruitful discussion on numerous topics.

VP (Technical) said we would update bye-law to version 19. VP (Technical) would remind bowlers on bye-law 1.17b about marker dress code. Markers could wear home side matching uniform, white uniform or club uniform (if other member clubs). Markers wore improper clothes or shoes, they could still play games, however, they could not advance to the next round.

Regarding side coaching issue, players from same side could discuss or provide advice. Third party could not disturb the games.

9 INTERNATIONAL

VP (International) reported the following:

We will send 6 male and 6 female players to Australia for training camp and participate in Victorian Open from 21-27 March, 2026.

Asian Lawn Bowls Championship and Under 25 Asian Lawn Bowls Championship were scheduled to hold between 5th April to 12th April, 2026 in the New Delhi, India. 14 players would be representing Hong Kong, China to participate. VP (International) said that we targeted to achieve result for Women's Pairs and Men's Triples so as to obtain a chance to play for these two disciplines at World Championship.

We were recruiting 2026-2027 Hong Kong, China Squad coaching team and had interview with applicants this week.

10 DISCIPLINARY PANEL

11 HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL BOWLS CLASSIC 2026, CLASSIC CARNIVAL and WORLD BOWLS JUNIOR INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP

Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2026 would be held in November at Hong Kong side. The President said the invitation letters have been sent to Division 1 member clubs. Classic Carnival planned to hold at Kowloon side before a week of Classic 2026 this year. Classic Carnival would welcome local players to play with overseas players and this subject to venue provided. World Junior Indoor Championship would be held in December.

12 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

12.1 The President said we would send out bye-law 19 to convenors tomorrow and ask for feedback before end of this month. The updated bye-law 19 targeted to endorse by the next meeting (27th April, 2026).

12.2 Regarding to AOB 12.2 on 9th February about Indoor Singles competition issue, VP

(Championship) said that we could try to ask more private clubs which had indoor rinks to hold it.

123 Regarding to AOB 12.4 on 9th February about changing the venue to hold Golden Bowls competition, VP (Championship) said we were hard to ask for venue to hold as we did not have LCSD subvention these years and HKCC was fully supported us these years. VP (Championship) would review it.

124 VP (Technical) said club jacket did not require to approve if it has been recognized by the member clubs. Club shirts shall have collars with sleeves and club logo did not require to send to LBA for approval. If the pants or skirts were not in white or cream colour, the design and fabric were required to seek for LBA approval. VP (Technical) would consider to discuss with umpire panel about the number of shoes approval per year and post the rejected shoes list for players' reference. The President support to maintain the tradition for lower body attire.
