REPORT BY THE HONORARY SECRETARY

The 2024-2025 was a fruitful but also a grievous year to our bowlers. The Association (LBA) organized two International Events, viz. the Hong Kong International Bowls Classic in November 2024 and the 2024 World Bowls Junior Indoor Championship in December 2024. These events demonstrated our abilities to organize international competitions and our commitment to the World Bowls community.

By end 2024 the total number of bowlers had increased significantly to approximately 5,577. There were two new bowling clubs, namely the SBI-Lawn Bowls Alumni Limited, joining us in July 2024 and the Happy Bowls Club joining us in September 2024. It amounts to 44 member clubs affiliated to LBA.

In 2024-2025, the headcount in Premier League and Triple League exceeded 5,500. As regards the National Competitions, LBA held 30 national competitions last year, creating a competitive environment for all local bowlers. An umpire training course was conducted during the report period with three candidates passing the examination. In respect of our Level 1 and Level 2 coaches, they conducted more than one hundred different training courses with satisfactory results.

Last year, the Hong Kong, China Squad took part in a number of overseas competitions with admirable results. The Squad successfully clinched five silver and four bronze medals at the Asian Lawn Bowls Championships and scaled new heights in other world competitions, including a bronze medal at the World Bowls Junior Indoor Championship.

During the second year of their elected term, all officers of the Council continued to serve devotedly to the bowls community. As regards the LBA office, Ms. Stephanie LAM resigned from the post of Sports Executive and was replaced by Ms. Hailey LAW in March 2025.

On behalf of the Association, I shall express our appreciation to the Culture, Sports and Tourism Bureau, Leisure and Cultural Services department, Hong Kong Sports Institute, Zhong Gang Muti-bowls Club, Otsuki Pharmaceutical Co. Ltd. and Ning Nam Medicine Factory (HK) Ltd. Their continual supports to LBA are indeed invaluable.

We are deeply saddened that we have lost our most respectful President, Mr. Vincent CHEUNG, who passed away on 12 April, 2025. Vincent had been serving as an Officer of the LBA since 1992 and taken hitherto presidency since 1999. He was the longest-serving lawn bowls leader in the world. His leadership has made lawn bowls even more accessible in Hong Kong, allowing people of all ages and walks to enjoy the sport. His contributions to the Association and the community at large are profound and long lasting. Vincent would be forever missed but never forgotten. Finally, I would like to express on behalf of all member clubs our deepest condolences to his wife, Mrs. Winnie Cheung and his family.

CLASSIC MEMORIES

Scotland dominates the men's competitions at Hong Kong Classic

The Scottish duo of Iain McLean and Darren Gualtieri dominated the Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2024 by winning both the men's singles and pairs title, while the Canadian women team broke their medal drought by winning their country's first ever Classic title.

Weather is the main theme of this year's Classic as it was hit by typhoon, heavy rain, gust of wind and the normal sunshine. It was the first in history that four consecutive typhoon hits Hong Kong in November.



At the exact time when the overseas players were briefed about the details of the event, typhoon Yinxing entered the perimeter of Hong Kong and the Storm Signal no. 1 was hoisted. In the middle of the first day of the singles, storm signal no.3 was announced as the tropical cyclone edging closer to Hong Kong. Players needed to play under occasional gust of wind. Luckily, the singles finals were not affected.

On the following Tuesday, typhoon Toraji edged close to the city and as a precautionary measure, the organizing committee switched the program for Wednesday and Thursday. The Thursday games were

played on Wednesday and Thursday will become a rest day. Storm signal no. 3 was hoisted in the middle of the second game on Wednesday and it was further escalated to no. 8 in the evening.



On Friday, typhoon Usagi entered the perimeter but fortunately was quickly turned its direction towards Taiwan. However its cross current costed heavy rain in the territory and all games were moved indoor.

The weather on Saturday was good until the closing stage of the semi-finals. Scotland and Ireland needed to play their last two ends in the tie-break under heavy rain and it was the Scottish who came out triumph. The rain did not stop and all finals was moved indoor for only the third time in the history of Classic.

In fact, just eight hours after the Classic closing dinner, typhoon Man-yi approached Hong Kong and the Storm Singal no.1 was hoisted. It did not create problem for Hong Kong and all players were flied home safely.

On the green, Iain McLean shown his real talent and helped Scotland to become the ninth team to collect both the pairs and singles titles in the same year. This is also his second Classic pairs title after his first success in 2013.

Men's Singles

McLean's route to the final starting from a 9:0 defeat in the first set against Benjamin Keung of Tuen Mun Sports Association. He crawled back to win the tie-breaker.



This early alarm woke up McLean and he won the following two matches against Cody Packer (Australia) and Desmond Hau (Kowloon Cricket Club) in straight set. In the quarter-final he defeated Adam Rankin from Ireland 9:7, 5:10, 1:2 and then beat Hong Kong Football Club's Stephen Sy 9:3, 7:7 to reach the final against Kyle Hansen from Australia.



Hansen defeated Hong Kong's knock-out singles champion Boota Singh in the first game, and went on to beat Homer Mercado (Philippines), World No.5 Harry Goodwin (England), Aaron Tennant (Ireland) and Daniel Davies Junior (Wales) before reaching the final.

The final was a tight game and both players displayed the highest quality of drawing skills. In most of the ends the whole head was within a one meter perimeter. While the holding position was frequently changed after each bowl was delivered, McLean always find a way to beat Hansen in most of the ends. This can be best illustrated in the last end when Mclean was holding a shot after delivered his third bowl. Hansen drew a toucher and rested 15cm behind the jack. McLean then drew his last bowl to sit between the gap of the jack and the shot bowl to win the end.

McLean won the singles final 5:8, 2:9.

McLean is delighted to win the title as this is his third time to played in the Classic singles, "My best result in the past was in the semifinals so it is a great feeling to win it this time. I think I played pretty well in the final and my bowl suits the environment better. Despite some pressure initially, especially in the second set, but once I took the three shots in the first end, it took the pressure off and I am happy to see how the results went."



Women's Singles

Local girls shone on international stage...again



Hong Kong representative won the women's Classic singles for the second year in a row. This year it was Hong Kong China team's Cheryl Chan to take over from Jenny Miu of Tseung Kwan O Bowling Club, who won the title last year. This is also the fourth local lady to win this title in its 13 years of history.

Chan began her journey with a walkover, then defeated Hong Kong China U23's Gillian Ng, Queenie Lai from Seabird Sports Association, Angel So of Craigengower Cricket Club and New Zealander Briar Atkinson to reach the final.

The other finalist is 2016 Classic Pairs winner Rosita Bradborn from Philippines. She defeated Emmie Wong from Hong Kong Football Club in the first round, then went on to beat Kelly Mckerihen (Canada), Suki Sit (Hong Kong Police Bowling Club), Helen Cheung (Hong Kong China) and Ysie White (Wales) enroute to the final.



In the final, both players were struggling a bit with the green but Chan displayed better weight control. She won the first

set 11:4. In the second set, Chan's performance dropped slightly and Bradborn started to manage the green and weight better. The Philippina won 8:7 to level on the sets.

In the tiebreaker, Chan was holding shots in each end and Bradborn needed to play heavy to save the end. However the results were not going her way and she lost 5:0 in three ends.



Chan feels surprise but was very happy to win the title, "I am not that nervous throughout the whole tournament and just playing my usual standard. I know I won't play well if I am nervous so just treat it as an usual game, and focus on the improvement of every shots. In the final I think my weight control is good but the green is a bit challenging.

When you take more greens, it will change the course a lot so weight control is more important in the final. My opponent was having problems adjusting to the weight so I win the game."

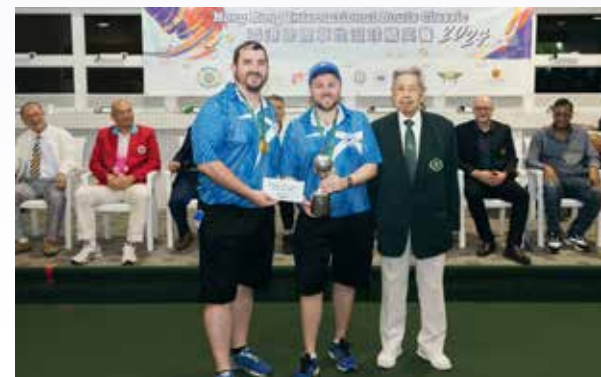
This is also her first title when representing Hong Kong so she is really happy about her achievement.



Men's Pairs

Scotland completed a clean sweep of men's titles

The Scottish combination of Iain McLean and Darren Gualtieri won 10 games in the roundrobin stage, with the only defeat came from Australia. In the other group, England's Tom McGuinness and Harry Goodwin won all the 11 games to top the table.



Scotland defeated New Zealand in the quarter-final 5:10, 11:4, 6:1 to meet Ireland in the semi-final. Scotland took the first set 9:5 but Ireland fought back strongly to win the second set 0:12. In the tiebreaker, rain started to intensify and affected the performance of both teams. Scotland won the first two ends by two shots each and Ireland can only pull two back in the last end.



England defeated the defending champion of Hizlee Rais and Izzat Shameer Dzulkeple in straight set 5:12, 3:8 in the quarter-final, and went on the defeat Hong Kong China 2:10, 8:4, 0:6 to reach the final.

The game was tight at the beginning. After each team took a shot in the first two ends, Scotland scored four in the third end with bowls only inches away from the jack. England fought back to take five shots in the next three ends to move ahead. In the seventh end, Goodwin accidentally took away

his team's bowl, allowing the Scottish to draw a third shot. The next end saw Goodwin burnt the end when he was one down, but still conceded four shots when the end was replayed. Scotland took one more shot in the last end to win the set 13:6.

The second set was tight as the first one when both team took two shots each in the first two ends. In the third end the England suddenly lost their drawing touch and lost three shots. The Scottish gradually took control and opened up a lead of 9:4 after the seventh end. The English fought back but can only finish the set 9:7.



McLean admitted that the final is a tough game, "It takes us a while to adjust and get used to the indoor green but my lead was settled really well and created a good platform for me to play some shots when it really matter. It is challenging throughout the tournament as we need to change from outdoor to indoor, and also needed to play in different weather condition, but we are really enjoy it"

He is over the moon after lifting both title, "It is such a difficult competition and there are some many good teams around. I will be delight to win one of them but winning two is incredible. It is one of the best bowling week in my life and it is thoroughly enjoyable."

Gualtieri also praised McLean for his performance, "We are in control in most of the ends but when we are in trouble, Iain plays some good bowls and releases us from the pressure."

Their other secret is that they changed to a narrower bowls to suit the indoor green, which apparently worked well for them.

Women's Pairs

Canada won first Classic title

In the women's pairs competition, the Australian team of Brianna Smith and Jessie Cottell topped their group with ten wins out of 11 matches. However, they did not get over the first hurdle in the knock-out stage and suffered a defeat in the hands of Canadian Emma Boyd and Kelly McKerihien, who finished fourth in the opposite group.



England's Emma Cooper and Harriet Stevens, who finished second behind New Zealand in the group stage, defeated Ireland in the quarter-final and face New Zealand again in the semi-final. This time they took revenge of their loss in the group stage and beat New Zealand 6:10, 10:5, 1:3 to reach the final.

The final is tight as both sides, barring Cooper, were struggling with the fast pace of the Craigengower Cricket Club indoor green.

England started well and was leading 1:4 after three ends. In the fourth end when England was holding three shots, McKerihien played a great shot to rest on the shot bowl to win one. In the following end when England was holding two in a tight head, Stevens' bowl was slightly heavier and pushed the jack to Canadian's bowl. Despite pulling one back from the next end, it was not enough to stop Canada to win the set 8:5.

In the second set the England team maintained its consistency in drawing to take the set 3:10 and forced the game into tie-breaker.

Both teams took one shot each in the first two ends in the tiebreaker. In the last tiebreaker, Cooper drew two bowls that was really close to the jack. McKerihien took the closest shot out with her first bowl. Her second bowl pushed the remaining shot closer to the jack. In her last bowl of the tournament, she played heavy again and took the shot out. Stevens tried to draw

with her last bowl but was stopped a meter in front of the jack.

McKerihien is absolutely thrilled to win it, "We have played most of the tournament outdoor so when the final moved indoor we need to take some time to adjust to the fast pace of the green. The English girls were playing quite well and forced the game into tiebreak. It was exciting to use the last bowl to taking out the shot and we are lucky enough to get the win.

"Overall it was a hard-fought game and I think our composure in the tiebreak was important. In the game we took it one bowl at a time and one end at a time. We need to make sure that all bowls are effective hence we got the results."

For Emma Boyd, her first trip to Hong Kong is particularly memorable, "Playing inside, outside, raining, sunshine, we have all the weather elements all at once, so it is important that you play one bowl at a time and try as best as you can and ultimately we can help each other to achieve the result. The variants in the conditions also make this win more valuable."

This is the first title for Canada in the 43 years history of the Classic.

The Hong Kong Classic was first started in 1981 when only the men's pairs was played. From then on, the event was expanded to include the men's singles and in 2008, after the amalgamation of the Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association and the Hong Kong Ladies Lawn Bowls Association, the women competition was introduced. It is now widely perceived as one of the best outdoor competitions in the world.

In 2019, the event was cancelled due to social unrest in Hong Kong. The event from 2020 to 2022 was not arranged due to the global COVID-19 pandemic.



This year the event was held at Craigengower Cricket Club, Hong Kong Football Club and Indian Recreation Club from November 9 to 17.

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TOURNAMENT World Bowls Junior Indoor Championship

Aussie gold and Maltese magic

New world champions have been crowned at the 2024 World Bowls Junior Indoor Championship. Staged at one of the most iconic sports venues in Asia, 42 players from 21 countries bid for glory in the men's singles, women's singles and mixed pairs competitions. Nine countries won medals – Australia's Kane Nelson being crowned a double world champion. The 20-year-old won men's singles gold and lifted the Jimmy Davidson Trophy, just hours after partnering Kira Bourke, 22, to mixed pairs success with an unblemished record during the tournament winning all seven of their games played.

Twenty-three-year-old Rebecca Rixon won Malta's first ever junior world singles gold medal and clinched the Hilary King MBE Trophy to add to her 2018 Commonwealth Games bronze and 2023 World Championships silver. It was something of an early birthday present as she turned 24 the day after the tournament finished! It was a treble success for the Australian state of Queensland where all three players are based. It's the fifth time, the Aussies have their names on the Doreen and Alec Miskelly Mixed Pairs Trophy, with previous winners being Kristina Kristic and Ben Twist in 2015 and Ellen Fife (nee Ryan) and Aaron Tey in 2016 and 2018. Corey Wedlock was champion in

2017 when he partnered Connie Rixon, the aforementioned Rebecca's elder sister. For the men's singles, Australia retained the title following Nathan Black's triumph in 2023. Nelson now joins Black, Aaron Tey, Aaron Wilson, Dylan Fisher, Ben Twist and Aron Sherriff as Australians with their name on the silverware. Men's singles silver went to Scotland's Paul Innes, while bronze medalists were Hong Kong China's Quenton Ip, a member of the Hong Kong Youth Development Team, and Cory Davies, Wales. In the women's singles, Angeleca Abatayo, gold medalist at this year's Lion City Cup and Asian Championship claimed The

Philippines' first medal at this level. Bronze medalists were Sophie McGrouther, Scotland – for the second year in a row – and Emma Boyd, Canada, who was the women's pairs champion in the recent Hong Kong Classic and former gold medalist in world junior mixed triples in 2017. Silver in the mixed pairs went to England's Ruby Hill, a previous winner of the event in 2022, and Aaron Johnson, recent Scottish International Open runner-up. It's the third year in succession England have been in the final. In 2022, Ruby won gold with Harry Goodwin, while 12 months ago in Scotland, Harry and Emily Kernick were runners-up to Ireland's Shauna O'Neill and Ryan McElroy.

Winning bronze were Lezandri Hildebrand and Alwyn Martignone (South Africa) and Sophie McGrouther and Paul Innes (Scotland), who both returned home as double medalists. Australia finished as the best performing country. The is is the second time the event has been staged in Asia, the first being in Malaysia in 2007. Several of the players featuring appear in World Bowls Series ranking list, including Boyd, 72nd, Hill 97th, McGrouther, 98th, Bourke 166th, Rixon 250th and Abatayo 252nd in the women's list and Nelson 146th and Rahim 239th in the men's. Co-sanctioned by the International Indoor Bowls Council, IIBC president Gordon Woods, of Scotland, said: "We've had a wonderful week of bowls. The Lawn Bowls Association of Hong Kong China and Hong Kong Football Club have been wonderful hosts. "It's been an amazing showcase in a fantastic venue and the event has showcased the great talent of the players from around the world and how the sport is growing globally."

The trophy and medal presentation party included Vincent Cheung, president of the Lawn Bowls Association of Hong Kong, China, Martin Gale, tournament director, Gordon Woods, president of the IIBC, Claudius Lam, director of World Bowls, Neil Roberts, honorary secretary of Hong Kong Football Club, and Esmond Lee, bowls convener of Hong Kong Football Club. World Bowls Series: The World Bowls Series is the official year-long calendar of sanctioned events connecting to the official world rankings. It is a joint venture between World Bowls and Tier 5 Ventures. WBS currently has 29 sanctioned events. Each WBS event will belong to a different tier having different ranking points based on the size, location, and stature it presents for the sport. The purpose of WBS is to build the profile and brand of bowls, showcase the best players in the game, accelerate the legitimacy of the sport on the global stage and launch world rankings that will help create clarity and interest in the sport of bowls.
