Conditions of play

1. All teams are required to report to the Duty Official with a minimum of 4 players 15 minutes before their first game. Late-comers will forfeit their first match to their opponent.
2. Fours. Two bowls per player.
3. A time limit of 55 minutes and 8 ends will apply for all matches. Matches will commence as signified by the duty official.
4. When time is up but a valid jack was delivered, the end will continue.
5. A jack in motion which goes out of bound or has otherwise become dead will be re-spotted to the fixed spot named "T" on the diagram, which is 2 metres from the ditch.
6. No trial end.
7. No visit to the head.
8. Lead, Second and Third to remain at mat end until after delivery of the second bowl of the Third of both teams.
9. In view of the tight schedule, all players are reminded to play with a smart pace, refrain from prolonged deliberations and be swift when crossing the rink. The duty official may take action against an act of slow play at his/her discretion if the progress of a match is deemed to be delayed.

Substitution

1. Only one substitute is allowed in each match. A minimum of 3 original players have to play in each match.
2. Substitute is not allowed to play as Skip irrespective of the number of matches played.
3. No team is allowed to play with less than 4 players.
4. Players and substitute in a team may not play in another team.
5. The Duty Official must be notified of any substitution prior to the start of a match.

General

1. All teams should wear matching uniform and proper lawn bowls attire. Failing to comply will result in the forfeit of the game(s) concerned.
2. Prize presentation ceremony to follow immediately after the completion of the Finals.
3. LBA reserves the right to alter the format and schedule of play, venue and allocated rinks, etc. to suit unforeseen circumstances.
4. In case of any disputes, decision of the Duty Official is final.
